Notes to the Muallim/ah

- This book has eleven lessons for the year.
- The Muallim/ah must remember that many of the children are not able to read and write as yet.
- The Muallim/ah should make this period an interesting one and should create the correct environment.
- Everybody loves stories and these lessons are stories, but with a difference i.e. there are lessons to be learnt.
- Questions on each lesson should be done orally with learners, as many have not as yet any writing and reading skills.

Method

Period 1

Ask the children to put everything away including rulers, rubbers, pencils etc.
 Now begin telling the story of Aadam Ask

Now begin telling the story of Aadam Ask the children if anyone's name is Aadam III. If there is no one with that name then ask them if they know of anyone with that name. Now ask them if they know where that name comes from. Some children may have an idea. Now go on to tell the story beginning with the first point. Do not concentrate too much on the vocabulary and only highlight the keywords. After telling the story once now ask one of the children to relate the story that they have heard. They may not be able to relate it accurately but the Muallim/ah can help them along by filling in the gaps.

Period 2

Put up the keywords and read it out to the pupils and ask the pupils if they remember the story. Give as many children the opportunity of telling the story and encourage the shy one to also try. *Insha Allah* in this way every child will have an opportunity to learn the story.

Period 3

- Now that everyone knows the story the main points should be elaborated upon i.e.
 - 1. The creation of Aadam and Hawwaa (alaihumas salaam).
 - 2. The trickery of the Shaitaan.
