

He ordered his soldiers to kill all the male children of the Banoo Israaeel.



Nabee Eesaa عَلَيْهِ السَّلَامُ grew up and began teaching people about Allaah. He told them to obey Allaah and love one another.


Allaah تعالى gave him the miracle of healing the sick, and giving sight to the blind.

His people loved and respected him as their leader.


Allaah تعانى gave him a special gift: He could understand the language of the birds, bees, ants, animals and the jinn.

The people of Makkah worshipped hundreds of different idols.



A few people believed in him, but most people laughed at him. They said that he was insane.





Nabee Muhammad صَلَى اللَّهُ عَلَيْه وَسَلَّمْ Hijrah




Nabee صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمُ lived in Makkah for 53 years.

Most people refused to listen to him. The Quraish tried very hard to stop the rise of Islaam. They secretly planned to kill Rasoolullah مَلَى اللّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلّمُ .

Allaah تَعَالَىٰ then ordered Rasoolullah تَعَالَىٰ to leave Makkah and go to Madeenah.

The migration from Makkah Mukarramah to Madeenah Munawwarah is known as the hijrah.

The journey between Makkah and Madeenah was very dangerous. The Quraish were searching for Nabee صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمْ so that they could kill him.

Nabee صَلَى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمُ was accompanied by Abu Bakr مرضى اللَّهُ عَنْهُ on the journey.

The Muslims of Madeenah, known as the Ansaar (helpers) gathered outside Madeenah to welcome Rasoolullah مُثَلُى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّم of praise in his honour.

Rasoolullah صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمُ built the first masjid in Qubah, a place near Madeenah

Munawwarah.

Nabee Muhammad صَلَى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمُ Life in Madeenah

The Ansaar (helpers) of Madeenah shared all their belongings with the Muslims who made the hijrah.

Nabee Muhammad صَلَى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمْ built a masjid in Madeenah called Masjid-un-Nabawee

The Muslims now had a city of their own where they could practice Islaam freely.

Nabee صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمُ performed Hajj ten years after hijrah. This was called the farewell Hajj.


Nabee صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمْ fell ill about three months after the hajj.

He passed away at the age of 63. He spent ten years in Madeenah

Nabee صَلَى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّم invited people to Islaam for twenty three years.

Rasoolullah صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمُ is buried in Masjid-un-Nabawee in Madeenah.

All of them were given duties, thus know them and respect them.

They are: Aadam; Idrees; Nooh; Hood; Saulih and Ibraaheem. Each one of them had followers.

Then comes: Loot; Ismaaeel and Ishaaq.

In this order. Yacoob; Yoosuf; and Ayyoob each one of them were rightly guided.

Shuayb; Haroon; Moosaa and Yasaa. Thul Kifl; Daawood and Sulaimaan. They had followers. Ilyaas; Yoonus and Zakariyya.

Eesaa and Muhammad who was the final of the messengers.

May the salutations of Allaah be upon the 'beloved' who was Ahmad the chosen one and the leader of the messengers. May salutations be upon his family and upon his companions, all of them.

Notes to the Muallim/ah-

- This book has eleven lessons and one poem for the year.
- The Muallim/ah must remember that many of the children are not able to read and write as yet.
- The Muallim/ah should make this period an interesting one and should create the correct environment.
- Everybody loves stories and these lessons are stories, but with a difference i.e. there are lessons to be learnt.
- Questions on each lesson should be done orally with learners, as many have not as yet any writing and reading skills.

Method

Period 1

Ask the children to put everything away including rulers, rubbers, pencils etc. Now begin telling the story of Moosaa Well. Ask the children if anyone's name is Moosaa Well. If there is no one with that name then ask them if they know of anyone with that name. Now ask them if they know where that name comes from. Some children may have an idea. Now go on to tell the story from the beginning with the first point. Do not concentrate too much on the vocabulary and only highlight the keywords. After telling the story once now ask one of the children to relate the story that they have heard. They may not be able to related it accurately but the Muallim can help them along by filling in the gaps.

Period 2

■ Put up the keywords and read it out to the pupils and ask the pupils if they remember the story. Give as many children the opportunity of telling the story and encourage the shy one to also try. *Insha Allah* in this way every pupil will have an opportunity to learn the story.

Period 3

- Now that everyone knows the story the main points should be elaborated upon i.e.
 - 1. The story of Moosaa عنها and Haw'wah رَضَى اللَّهُ عَنْهَا
 - 2. The cruelty of Firoun.
 - 3. His mother putting him in the basket. Ask them to answer the questions orally.

Period 4

- Colour in all keywords.
- Revision of the story.
