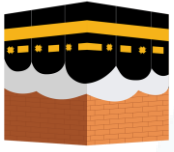

# HAJJ



A pillar of Islam that has to be carried out by people who have enough money to do so. Hajj is a journey during Zul Hijjah to Makkah and surroundings to perform certain actions of worship to Allah following the example of Ibrahim Alayhis salam.

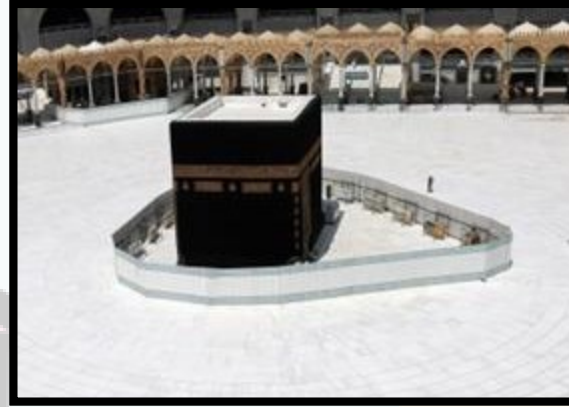




**KA'BAH**



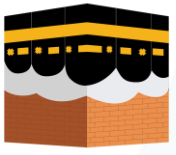
The House of Allah – situated in Makkah. It is a square building covered with a black sheet.

SA'EE



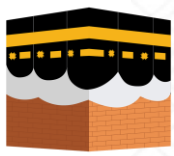
Walking/Running between  
Safa and Marwah.



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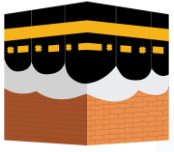
# IHRAAM



A state in which a person is in before entering Makkah where certain actions are not allowed. Men wear 2 white sheets.

Women do not have a specific type of clothing to wear.





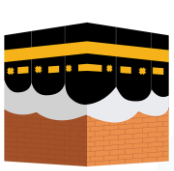
# TALBIYAH



A dua that the people on Hajj read often  
which means “I am present, Oh Allah”

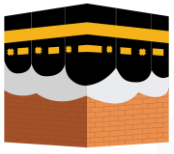
# JAMARAAT



The 3 Pillars in Mina which are stoned by the people on Hajj that take the place of Shaytaan which Ibrahim Alayhis Salaam stoned.







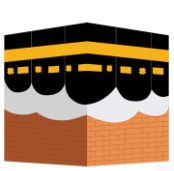
# MINA



A tent city which is 6km from Makkah where people on Hajj spend Day 1, 3, 4 and 5 completing various actions. The Jamaraat are in Mina.





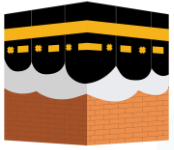


# ARAFAH



Arafah is the blessed area where people on Hajj spend the main day of Hajj. Spending time in Arafah is compulsory on Hajj. This is the 9<sup>th</sup> of Zul Hijjah / Day 2. The main act of worship they carry out here is Dua.



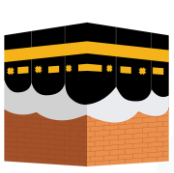


# MUZDALIFAH




Muzdalifah is the blessed area where people on Hajj spend the night of 9<sup>th</sup> Zul Hijjah (before 10<sup>th</sup>) to collect the stones they need to stone the Shaytaan. They sleep in the open area under the stars.
